REWARD UP TO \$5 MILLION FOR INFORMATION ON EXPORTS OF LUXURY GOODS TO NORTH KOREA

Rewards for Justice is seeking information on any shipment or transfer of luxury items to North Korea, including luxury automobiles, designer clothing, jewelry, alcohol, tobacco, perfume, or other similar items.

REWARD UP TO \$5 MILLION FOR INFORMATION ON NORTH KOREAN FORCED LABOR

The North Korean government forces its citizens to work abroad under surveillance and tight control to help fund the regime's weapons of mass destruction programs.

REWARD OF UP TO \$10 MILLION FOR INFORMATION ON FOREIGN INTERFERENCE IN U.S. ELECTIONS



Rewards for Justice is seeking information on any foreign person or entity that violates federal criminal, voting rights, or campaign finance law, or who has knowingly engaged or is engaging in vote tampering, database intrusions, influence operations, disinformation, bot farm campaigns, or related malicious cyber activity to interfere in U.S. elections.

Remember, however, that this is not your Granddad's tip line. The Fed's preferred method of contact is to use their Tor Network link. **Willie Sutton** robbed banks because that's where the money was. The Feds use TOR to find cyber informants because that's where the cyber crooks hang out. The message being Don't Call Us even if we do publish a telephone number.

DOES REWARDS FOR JUSTICE ACCEPT PHONE CALLS?

The program does not process tip information by telephone except under exceptionally rare circumstances.

If you have useful information, please write to us via RFJ's language-specific tip lines or our TOR-based tip channel. We will pass useful information to the appropriate government authorities for further consideration.

Individuals providing useful information may be eligible for a reward.
